### What's it all about?

These trips are called charity challenges. A charity challenge is a physically demanding fundraising event, either overseas or in Australia, aimed at getting you out of your comfort zone, raising funds for wonderful charities and having an incredible life-changing experience.

This is your chance to do something you have always dreamt of doing whilst making a difference to a cause you feel connected to. Stop a man raising his hand to his wife or children after attending one of our seminars or workshops (\$500).

Provide a shaded area for kids to play at a refuge providing shelter for mothers and their children.

## Trip Notes

### Day 1 : Thu 19 Aug : Alice Springs

Your trip starts in Alice Springs, in the heart of Central Australia. Today is just an arrival day, so no activities are planned. Please make your own way to our centrally-located joining hotel (details are in your travel documents). In the evening we meet our tour leader at a Welcome Meeting. Our leader will give us a briefing on what lies ahead. After the meeting we will dine at a local restaurant

### Day 2 : Fri 20 Aug : Alice Springs – Ormiston Pound

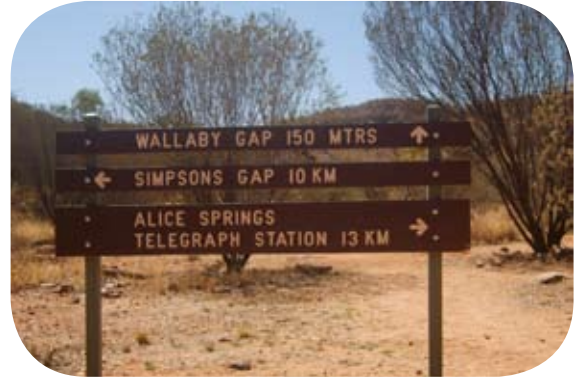
After breakfast (approx 0700hrs) we will depart Alice Springs travelling through the heart of the West MacDonnell Ranges to a location regarded by many as the most spectacular section of the Larapinta Trail. The Ormiston Pound Walk is an amazing experience, sensational visions, brilliant colour contrasts, enormity and sheer beauty. This 4.5 hour experience within the 1500million year old region will leave you in awe. Whilst you have been trekking the ground support crew have been setting up the base camp. You will return to relax on the banks of the mighty Finke River, peaceful & stunning spectacular. Enjoy your first evening veiled with the million stars of the Milky Way.

Meals included: 1 breakfast, 1 lunch, 1 dinner

### Day 3 : Sat 21 Aug : Glen Helen – Ormiston Gorge

After breakfast we set off to walk Section 10, a 9.9 km section of the Larapinta Trail that can easily be walked in a day. It is suitable for people of average fitness, used to walking long distances, with some steep ascents. This is one of the shorter sections of the Larapinta Trail and winds through rolling limestone hills at the headwaters of the Finke River, one of the world's oldest rivers. The many water holes and river gum trees provide sanctuary to many types of birdlife. There are plenty of surprises in store on this section. Do not forget your binoculars.

## Day 4 : Sun 22 Aug : Mount Sonder – Kings Creek Station

Our final day of Larapinta Trekking sees us tackling Section 12, a 15.8 km return section. The challenging climb to the peak of Mount Sonder (1380m) rewards every trekker with 360 degree visions that are difficult to describe. The breath taking views in all directions. Ranges, plains, valleys and salt lakes as the new day dawns combines to create a magnificent climax to the Larapinta Challenge. This is a great place to experience the grandeur of the desert landscape. After descending we meet our support crew and travel the Mereenie Loop via Gosse Bluff, Areyonga, The Krichauff & Razorback escarpments, McGintys Lookout & Kings Canyon Resort to the picturesque Sunset at Kings Canyon. A short distance later we will arrive at our remote bush campsite at Kings Creek Station and another great night under the stars.

## DAY 5 : Mon 23 Aug : Kings Creek Station – Uluru/ Kata Tjuta National Park

After breakfast today we head off by road to Uluru-Kata Tjuta National Park, via Curtin Springs Station, arriving at approx 11am. A 2.5 hour walk around Uluru is a great way to best understand the natural and cultural significance of this special place. During our 11 kilometre amble, our guides will introduce us to the geology of Uluru and describe how plants and wildlife have adapted and survived in such a harsh environment. But most fascinating of all is the relationship of the Anangu people to Uluru. For them this place provided shelter and water and a tangible link to their creation ancestors. As we walk around the base we hear and see the creation time stories of these ancient people unfold and see where the people lived and carried out ceremonies. Here, the beliefs of the people are embodied in one of the great places of this world. From a distance Uluru is spectacular; from close up it is powerful and deeply moving. We have time to freshen up at our hotel before we enjoy a spectacular Sounds of Silence dinner for our final night together. Your journey begins on a lone sand dune. A path takes you to an uninterrupted, three hundred and sixty degree view of this vast landscape. In front of you is the fabled Uluru; behind you are the domes of Kata Tjuta and, possibly the most spectacular sunset you have ever seen. As the sun sets, you feast on a BBQ buffet of authentic Australian delicacies including barramundi, kangaroo, emu, crocodile, bush salads and classic desserts, complemented by some of Australia's finest wines.

## DAY 6 : Tues 24 Aug : Adventure Ends

Our trip ends in the morning after breakfast. The resort provides a shuttle to the airport.

## Frequently Asked Questions

### How fit do I need to be?

Our adventures are challenging and they require everyone who participates in them to embark on a fitness training program. We advise you to speak to your GP about your fitness goals, and a personal trainer to have a fitness training plan developed. Our adventures are specifically designed so that people who are relatively fit and who are willing to seriously train can complete them. We can't think of a more exciting fitness goal! Go for it!

### When does the fundraising target need to be paid?

The fundraising target is made up of various payments, which need to be met in order to secure your place on the adventure. A travel deposit needs to be paid to our travel partner when you register, and a fundraising deposit is payable to Australia's CEO Challenge 12 weeks prior to departure. The balance of your travel cost is payable 60 days prior to departure and the balance of the fundraising component is payable 4 weeks prior to departure.

### What is the minimum age for participants? What is the general age range?

On the majority of our trips the minimum age is 12+ years old (up to 17 years old) if accompanied by an adult (please check with us.) We have had participants of all ages from 16 – 70 years, all united by their sense of adventure.

### Can I extend my stay?

Yes, many of our participants decide to extend their stay to get the most from their overseas adventure! Additional travel arrangements are at your own cost and an administration fee may apply.

### Will I get a chance to meet the other trekkers before I go?

Yes, we will organise a get-together evening for everyone (geography permitting). There will be regular email and phone communications leading up to the trip. We will also set up an online community on Facebook for this adventure so you can meet other participants.

### Can I pay the whole amount myself?

Yes, you can, or you can pay for part of it and fundraise the remainder. Do whatever works for you, as long as you reach the target by the deadline.

## Why would people want to sponsor me?

When you take on an Inspired Adventure, you are embarking on a physical challenge that requires varying levels of training and fitness. None of our challenges are a “walk in the park” and training is essential. By supporting you, people are supporting Australia’s CEO Challenge. In order to make it on the trip you need to raise the funds and your determination and inspiration will encourage those you approach to support you. Inspired Adventures are not holidays – they are physically challenging fundraising events that will raise vital funds for Australia’s CEO Challenge.

## How will people know that I am authorised to fundraise?

Upon registration, you will be sent a fundraising proposal form and conditions of fundraising. Once you have signed this form and returned it to us Australia’s CEO Challenge will issue you with an Authority to Fundraise in the form of a letter. Inspired Adventures is a member of the Fundraising Institute of Australia and we follow the fundraising best practice guidelines.

## Will I reach my target?

Yes you will, providing you have a good plan of action and at least 3 months to implement it.

## Here are some examples:

- Online Fundraising/Donations \$1,500
- Trivia Night with silent auction \$3,000
- Selling chocolates \$400
- Morning tea \$600
- Garage sale \$500



## Are donations tax-deductible?

All of the money that goes directly to the charity over \$2 may be tax-deductible provided it is a direct donation. Australia's CEO Challenge will issue a receipt, provided that addresses are supplied. If you are using an online fundraising page, receipts are issued directly to your donor. Donations are an unencumbered gift, being money given to the charity for nothing in return. This does not include purchasing of any item e.g. raffle tickets, dinner and/or goods of any kind. The money that goes towards the travel component of your overall target is not tax-deductible.

## How much of the money I raise will go to the charity?

Australia's CEO Challenge has decided on your fundraising target of \$4,500 and once the travel cost has been deducted from the amount you raise, Australia's CEO Challenge receives the balance. Australia's CEO Challenge will receive approximately \$1,490 minimum from each participant.

## What are the costs to me?

A registration fee of \$700 (with the option to pay \$350 then \$350 balance 4 weeks later). You should also make note of the items specified in the "What's not included" section below.

- Trek Leader (2 leaders for group)
- Support vehicle
- Swags and camping equipment
- Sightseeing and entrance fees as outlined in the itinerary
- Transport: Private vehicle, on foot
- Accommodation: 2 nights comfortable hotel, 3 nights outback camping
- Meals: 5 breakfasts, 4 lunches, 5

- Travel Insurance
- Items of a personal nature; gratuities, postage, drinks and souvenirs
- Other meals as required
- Additional optional activities
- Domestic airfares
- Airport and Airline Taxes

# Inspired Adventures and Peregrine Adventures Booking Conditions

## CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

This Inspired Adventure is operated by Peregrine Adventures Pty Ltd, trading as Peregrine Adventures their head office in Melbourne, Australia ("Peregrine"). Peregrine Adventures Pty Ltd are members of the Tui Travel group of companies, of Crawley Business Quarter, Fleming Way, Crawley, West Sussex, RH10 9GX, United Kingdom.

Please read carefully the terms in the conditions of contract in completing and submitting the Booking Form, you agree to be bound by these conditions which constitute the agreement between Inspired Adventures, Peregrine Adventures Pty Ltd (Peregrine Adventures) and you. The conditions apply to the exclusion of any other terms or conditions unless they are set out in the Booking Form, or are otherwise agreed to in writing by the parties. Previous dealing with the parties will not vary these conditions. No purported variation of these conditions will be effective unless in writing and signed by a person so authorised by Inspired Adventures and Peregrine Adventures.

**1. How to Book:** To participate in this Inspired Adventure, you must pay a non-refundable registration fee of AUD\$700 including GST payable to Inspired Adventures. Six weeks later you must pay a non-refundable travel deposit of AUD\$400 including GST which must be made payable to Peregrine Adventures. If you register within 4 months of the departure date you must pay the travel deposit of AUD\$400 immediately upon registration.

**2. Payments and Fundraising:** Eligibility to take part in this Challenge is contingent upon you raising the minimum Fundraising Target. Peregrine Adventures will not accept receipt of your balance payment until there is evidence that your Fundraising Deposit of AUD\$1,000 has been met 12 weeks prior to your departure. The balance of your Fundraising Payments must be made no later than 4 weeks prior to your departure. Travel costs are based on arrangements departing from Sydney and exclude Airline taxes and levies, Travel Insurance, Visa Fees. Peregrine Adventures may be able to arrange travel from other cities in Australia, a surcharge will apply. Registered participants will be required to cover additional travel or accommodation costs required as a result of departing from an alternative destination. Failure to lodge the fundraising target on or before the required date will render you ineligible to depart on the Challenge and you will forfeit in full the AUD\$700 registration fee paid to Inspired Adventures, the AUD\$400 travel cost deposit paid to Peregrine Adventures, and your place on the adventure. All monies raised in the name of the charity must be forwarded immediately to the charity along with supporting documents as outlined in the 'Conditions for Fundraisers'. Inspired Adventures, Peregrine Adventures, and the charity reserve the right to refuse your Application to Register. Their decision is final and binding. Should your Application be refused your full registration fee will be refunded to you. Your registration for the Challenge will take effect once your registration funds have cleared. Places are limited on the Challenge and are allocated on a first come first served basis.

**3. Amendments:** If you wish to alter any of your arrangements, you should notify Peregrine Adventures in writing and the changes will take effect upon receipt by Peregrine Adventures. Any amendment received by Peregrine Adventures within 56 days of departure date will incur a AUD\$50 administration fee per amendment. By definition, an amendment is any change that you make to your booking once your registration has been received.

**4. Late Bookings:** For bookings made within 15 days prior to departure, Peregrine reserves the right to charge a late booking fee of \$50 per booking. On some trips it is not possible for us to accept late bookings.

**5. Changes To Your Holiday:** You acknowledge that travelling with Peregrine requires a degree of flexibility, good humour, and an understanding that the itinerary, accommodation, and/or modes of transport may change, even after a tour's commencement, without prior notice due to local circumstances. Changes may occur because of 'Force Majeure', poor road conditions, weather, the availability of tickets, vehicle breakdowns, changes in transport schedules, or other circumstances beyond Peregrine's control or which simply cannot be foreseen. Peregrine does not accept any responsibility for loss of enjoyment, delays or compensation resulting from circumstances beyond Peregrine's control.

The information about trips given in Trip Notes and Pre-Departure Information are subject to change. It is your responsibility to review the up-to-date Trip Notes and Pre-Departure Information. These can be obtained from Peregrine. The information and conditions in the Trip Notes and Pre-Departure Information are deemed to be part of the contract. Where changes to your trip occur after you have received your final documentation we will, where practical, advise you of such changes.

**6. Cancellations by You:** If you wish to cancel your tour, you must notify Inspired Adventures and Peregrine Adventures in writing and the following charges will apply: You will automatically forfeit your registration fee (AUD\$700), your travel cost deposit (AUD\$400 – if you cancel up to 56 days prior to departure) or 50% of monies paid to Peregrine Adventures (if you cancel between 56-30 days prior to departure), or 100% of monies paid to Peregrine Adventures (if you cancel less than 30 days prior to departure) or fundraised for but not yet paid to the charity.

If there are too few participants on your tour we reserve the right to cancel the Challenge or to offer you alternatives. If the Challenge is cancelled and any alternatives offered are not suitable, you shall be refunded any monies paid to Peregrine Adventures but shall not be entitled to claim any other amounts. In the event that your chosen trip is cancelled and you are given the option of transferring to a trip the following year, these transferred trips must be taken within 12 months or your position on the Challenge will be forfeited.

**7. Cancellation by Peregrine Adventures:** Peregrine reserves the right to cancel a departure and will advise you of such cancellations no later than 56 before the tour departure date. If due to 'Force Majeure' or government travel advice, Peregrine reserves the right to cancel a departure at any time. With any form of cancellation, Peregrine will offer you alternative arrangements, and if the price of your alternative booking is of lower value than the original booking we will refund the difference to you. If you do not accept alternative arrangements we will refund all payments you have made to Peregrine, (in case of 'Force Majeure' or government travel advice refunds will be less any unrecoverable costs). Peregrine will not be liable for any additional costs incurred by you.

Force Majeure

Peregrine will not be liable for any delay in, change to or cancellation of trips due to 'Force Majeure'. 'Force Majeure' means a circumstance beyond the reasonable control of Peregrine and includes, but is not limited to, war or threat of war, riot, civil strife, terrorist activity, industrial dispute, disease, industrial or nuclear disaster, adverse weather conditions, fire and strikes.

**8. Prices and Availability:** All prices are based on costs and exchange rates applicable when the tour, airfare and taxes quote is provided to Inspired Adventures. Peregrine reserves the right to adjust prices whether or not you have already made full payment. We will do everything within our control not to adjust prices and will generally only amend prices in the event of marked fluctuations in exchange rates, fuel costs, airlines increasing the cost of airfares & Taxes and other operating costs on which prices are based. All air, train and trekking permit arrangements are subject to availability at the time you pay your deposit to Peregrine. If we are unable to confirm trekking permits or air and train arrangements for you at that time, we will offer you alternative options or refund your \$400 deposit back to you. If we are unable to obtain availability for the airfare that was quoted, we will confirm the next available airfare for you and advise you of the increased cost.

**9. Health, Fitness, Trip Grades and Age Limits:** It is your responsibility to advise Peregrine of any pre-existing medical condition and/or disability that might reasonably be expected to increase the risk of you requiring medical attention, or that might affect the normal conduct of a tour and the enjoyment of other trip members. You may be required to provide an assessment of your medical condition from a qualified medical practitioner if requested by Peregrine or our suppliers. Peregrine reserves the right, at its reasonable discretion, to cancel your booking and refund the money paid by you, less any unrecoverable costs. Peregrine also reserves the right to cancel your participation in a trip at any time, including after the commencement of your trip, with no right of refund if your medical condition and/or disability could be reasonably expected to affect the normal conduct of the trip and the enjoyment of other trip members.

All travellers seventy years and over will be required to complete a special Peregrine health and fitness questionnaire to assess their suitability of the tour in question. At the discretion of Peregrine, travellers may also be required to provide a doctor's letter clearing them for their specific tour.

The decision for any person under 18 years of age to travel on our itineraries is at the absolute discretion of the management of Peregrine. For further information please contact Peregrine Adventures.

**10. Authority of the Leader:** At all times the decision of the Peregrine leader, or representative ("Peregrine Leader") will be final on all matters likely to affect the safety and well-being of the trip. This includes any decision that the Peregrine Leader makes about your on-going participation in the trip or certain activities that comprise part of the trip. If you fail to comply with a decision made by a Peregrine Leader, or interfere with the well-being of the group, then the Peregrine Leader reserves the right to terminate this contract and order you to leave the tour immediately, with no right of refund.

**11. Complaints:** If you have any complaint about your trip, you must make it known at the earliest opportunity to the leader and/or Peregrine local representative, who will normally be able to take appropriate action. If at the end of the trip you feel your complaint has not been properly dealt with you must notify us in writing within 30 days of the end of your trip.

**12. Travel Insurance:** Adequate and valid travel insurance is compulsory for all Peregrine travellers. Your travel insurance must cover accidents, injury, illness and death medical expenses, including any related to pre-existing medical conditions, emergency repatriation (including helicopter rescue and air ambulance where applicable) and personal liability. Peregrine also recommends it covers cancellation, curtailment and loss of luggage and personal effects. You must carry proof of insurance with you and produce it if reasonably requested by Peregrine's employees or suppliers. Peregrine reserves the right to cancel or suspend your participation on a trip or in certain activities that comprise part of a trip, at any time, including after the commencement of your tour, with no right of refund, if you are unable to provide proof of insurance when requested.

**13. Your Trip and Assumption of Risk:** Peregrine operates trips in regions where standards of accommodation, transport, safety, hygiene, medical facilities and other infrastructure may, at times, not be of the standard that you are used to at home. Infrastructure may, at times, not be of the standard that you are used to at home.

By booking with us you acknowledge that participation in all Peregrine trips involves inherent risks that may not be present in the case of conventional or less demanding holidays. These risks include, without limitation, the possibility of injury or death,

psychological trauma, disease, loss or damage to property, inconvenience and discomfort. The possibility of experiencing all or some of these risks is likely to be higher if participation in a Peregrine trip involves visiting remote or unstable regions, or regions where there is dangerous wildlife.

When assessing whether trips will operate Peregrine uses information from its local offices in conjunction with advice from the Australian Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade, the British Foreign Office and the US Department of State. It is your responsibility to acquaint yourself with the travel advice provided by these government bodies, as well as that of your country of residency, before commencing the trip. By booking with Peregrine you acknowledge your decision to travel on a Peregrine trip is made after due consideration of relevant travel information that may be made available at any time.

**14. Exclusion of Liability:** Except where stated otherwise, Peregrine acts as agent for service providers when making arrangements for your trip. Where Peregrine provides services it will do so with due care and skill. Peregrine is not responsible for the acts and omissions of others, including tour guides, airlines and accommodation providers or for any loss, damage, death, injury or expense (including loss of money paid in advance), which you may incur as a consequence of the acts and omissions of others. You warrant that you have not relied on any representation made by Peregrine or other Representative, which has not been stated expressly in the tripnotes.

Peregrine will not accept responsibility or liability if you contravene any law or regulation of any country or region visited. Any independent arrangements that you make that are not part of the Peregrine trip (including pre- and post accommodation) are entirely at your own risk and Peregrine cannot and does not give you any assurance, representation or warranty in connection with any such arrangements.

To the fullest extent permitted by law and subject to the exception set out below, Peregrine does not accept liability for any loss, damage, death or injury however caused (including through negligence), which you may directly or indirectly suffer in connection with or arising from this contract or your participation in a trip, or in respect of a failure or omission on the part of Peregrine to comply with its obligations under this contract, or in respect of any other conduct that Peregrine undertakes in connection with a trip. To the fullest extent permitted by law and subject to the exception set out below, you also agree to release Peregrine and its officers, employees, agents and representatives ("Representatives") from all costs, liability, loss and damage incurred by you in connection with your participation in any trip, and waive any associated claims that you may have against Peregrine or its Representatives as a result of your participation in any trip. For these purposes, Peregrine enters into these Booking Conditions as trustee or agent for its Representatives.

To the fullest extent permitted by law and subject to the exception set out below, any condition or warranty, which would otherwise be implied into these Booking Conditions is excluded. Where legislation implies any condition or warranty, and that legislation prohibits us from excluding or modifying the application of, or our liability under, any such condition or warranty, that condition or warranty will be deemed included but our liability will be limited for a breach of that condition or warranty to one or more of the following: (a) if the breach relates to goods, (i) the replacement of the goods or the supply of equivalent goods, (ii) the repair of such goods, (iii) the payment of the cost of replacing the goods or of acquiring equivalent goods or (iv) the payment of the cost of having the goods repaired; and (b) if the breach relates to services, (i) the supplying of the services again or (ii) the payment of the cost of having the services supplied again.

Exception

The "Exclusion of Liability" section set out in these Booking Conditions does not attempt or purport to exclude, restrict or modify liability arising under, or remedies that may be available to you, pursuant to legislation where the exclusion, restriction or modification of liability or remedies is not permitted. This includes legislation in part of the Trade Practices Act 1974 (Cth), and any state or territory Fair Trading Act (or its equivalent).

**15. Visas and Passports:** You are responsible for obtaining all necessary immunisations and visas and bear the expense for the same. Peregrine Adventures staff are able to advise you about this. You must have a valid passport, which has at least six months validity beyond your return date.

**16. Exclusions from package price:** The following items are not limited to or included in the participation fee: Visas and passport charges; any additional charges resulting if not departing from Sydney (this includes any additional accommodation required due to 'forced' stopovers on your journey to or from the destination); ticketable & non-ticketable airline departure, airport and airline taxes; extra meals not included in the itinerary; laundry, postage, personal clothing, medical expenses and items of a personal nature; aerated or alcoholic beverages; emergency evacuation charges; excess baggage charges; travel insurance; tips; any pre or post tour arrangements; single accommodation as all prices are twin share.

**17. Disclaimer:** You accept that:

- Peregrine Adventures acts as a booking agent for third-party tour operators and accepts no liability for the acts or omissions of those third-party tour operators; and
- Inspired Adventures, Peregrine Adventures, and the charity reserve the right to refuse my Application to Register. Their decision is final and binding. Should my Application be refused my full registration fee will be refunded to me. My registration for the Challenge will take effect once my registration funds have cleared. Places are limited on the Challenge and are allocated on a first come first served basis, and
- Peregrine Adventures will not be liable for any breach of any law by any person with whom you travel on the tour; and
- you may not rely on any representations concerning the tour made by Peregrine Adventures which are not contained in these conditions.

**18. Release and Waiver of Liability:** In consideration of Inspired Adventures and Peregrine Adventures accepting your booking application and in consideration of you being permitted by Inspired Adventures and Peregrine Adventures to join the tour:

- you waive any and all claims I may now or in the future have against Inspired Adventures, its officers, employees, agents or representatives ("its staff") and release from all liability and agree not to sue Inspired Adventures or its staff for any personal injury, death, property damage or loss sustained by me as a result of my participation in the Challenge. You acknowledge that the Challenge involves an adventure trip and accept all the inherent risks associated with such a trip and the possibility of personal injury, death or property damage or loss resulting there from.
- you release Peregrine Adventures and its officers, employees, agents, licensees, guides and other representatives and the land management authorities in the countries in which the tour is conducted (each of whom are collectively referred to as "Peregrine Adventures and its employees") from all cost, liability, loss or damage incurred or suffered by you directly or indirectly during the course of the tour and resulting from your personal injury, illness or death or damage to or loss of your property unless caused by the wilful negligence or wrongful act of Peregrine Adventures and its employees; and
- you waive any claims you have, or may at any time have, against Peregrine Adventures and its employees and you agree, by accepting the additional inherent dangers and risks associated with the tour, not to make any claim against or seek any compensation from Peregrine Adventures and its employees in respect of any personal injury, illness or death suffered by you or damage to or loss of property sustained by you as a result of your participation in the tour.

To the extent permitted by law, section 74 of the Trade Practices Act 1974 does not apply to this contract.

**19. Privacy:** In order to be able to supply a service to you Peregrine will need to collect certain information from you, some of which may be of a personal nature. The information may be disclosed to, or collected on our behalf by our service providers to enable the services to be provided, but will not be used by them for any other purpose.
